Our mission is to start a non-profit organization that will give a “*day of normalcy*” to men who have initiated trying to put their lives back together. These men are enrolled in an intense 6-month Men’s Recovery program operated by the Drop Inn Center in downtown Cincinnati. They are encouraged to find jobs and eventually go back to the families they left behind. The success rate of this awesome program is 85%.

Anthony Munoz was the recent speaker at the graduation, and the program is currently looking for more local celebrities to participate as hosts and speakers for the graduation programs.
